



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS / GUARDIANS / SPECTATORS

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them.
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials.
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Never force your child to take part in sport.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performance of **all** children taking part in coaching, matches and/or any other Club event.
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Publicly accept officials' judgments.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their hockey.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Parents/Carers **MUST** accompany their children to the playing area and ensure that the Coach(es) and/or Official(s) are present rather than "*just drop them off*" in the car park.
- Parents must turn up on time to collect their child(ren) from coaching sessions, matches and/or any other Club event.

Please note Bramhall Recreation Centre facilities are used by other groups and are accessible by members of the general public. Therefore if your child is using the shared changing and toilet facilities prior to commencing a coaching session or match we request that you accompany them.
